Parental Rights and Involvement

- Details instructional time
- Details frequency of delivery of content
- Defines ages or grade levels at which specific content is delivered

Use of External Agencies or Organizations

- Describes resources and referral sources that can be provided to students
- Details when an outside educator can and should be used

Monitoring of Program Implementation

- Describes how the program will be monitored
- Details the support provided to sites
- Ensures implementation is in accordance with policy

Monitoring of Professional Development <ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Details plan to provide oversight of professional development activities<input type="checkbox"/> Details requirements for ongoing evaluation of educator capacities<input type="checkbox"/> Details plan for provision of ongoing technical assistance to educators, including selection of professional requirements of those who provide technical assistance
